Wedemeier is doing a great job negotiating higher rates.

Investment Strategy, Depositories, Authorized signatories: Carland presented the investment strategy, named depositories and signatories. *Motion* by Kitchen with support by Miller to recommend to the Board that the current investment strategy and named depositories be renewed, with funds diversified so that no more than 50% of BTA's assets are in one financial institution, with a limit of \$250k per institution with the exception of Michigan Class. The Committee also recommends the Board add Sophia Hogarth and the 2024-2025 Board Chair be added as authorized signatories. All ayes, *motion carried*.
